Open to ages 6 - 10. This class will support student's interest in development of basic soccer skills, such as: dribbling, kicking, shooting on goal, and using "feet only".

_____ Open Art Studio – 3:30 – 4:30 (Art Room)

Open to ages 8 - 15. Open Art Studio will offer an opportunity for students to choose, plan, and execute independent art projects. Students will not only be working towards complete independence in the art-making setting, but will be responsible for gathering, organizing, and cleaning up all of their materials. In addition, artists will work to develop plans to carry out their art projects. This class is designed for students who are interested in art and excited to create and develop their own collection of masterpieces!

This course will be highly focused on building upon students' executive functioning skills:

Planning: Students will manage both future and current tasks in order to complete their projects in a timely manner. If needed support will be provided through graphic organizers. **Organization:** Students will be responsible for choosing, storing, maintaining, and cleaning their materials and space. **Self-monitoring:** Students will be asked to work independently, and to self-monitor their time.

_____ Transportation Club – 3:30 – 4:30 (Victory Campus and off-site)

Open to ages 11 – 19. Students participating in this class will learn about multiple modes of transportation and how to utilize each type to suit their needs. Areas of exploration will be tailored to each student in the class and may include, but not be limited to: bus/max, train, planes, boats, uber/lyft, biking, and ride share. Each week, students will also learn about the skills needed for each mode of transportation, such as safety and security, buying tickets or “rides” on apps, reading schedules, etc. Parents should prepare for several off-site pick-ups of their students according to a schedule provided after class begins.

_____ Cross Country – 3:30 – 4:30 (Victory Campus and off-site)

Open to ages 11 – 19. Students in this after school club will train to run cross country trails in the beautiful outdoors, with the ultimate goal of participating in a 5k run in December. Each week, students will train at the school or off site on local Wilsonville trails, and focus on: proper running form, warm ups and cool downs, racing etiquette, and stamina. Tuesday (9/25 – 12/11)

_____ Sensory Art - 3:30 – 4:30 (Art Room)

Open to ages 6 - 10. This class will focus on discovery and exploration in the context of art making. The artists in this class will get a little messy, but all in the name of sensory experiences and art. The materials will be many and varied, including but not limited to: clay, paint, glue, water, sand, textured paper, and more. While students will be working as a class to move through step-by-step directions to make their art independently, they will be practicing the fine motor skills needed to create art, using materials safely and appropriately, and cleaning up when their masterpieces are completed.

_____ Soccer Kicks - 3:30 – 4:30 (Community Room/Outside)

Open to ages 8 - 11. This class is designed to teach or reinforce the fundamentals of soccer skills, overall fitness, knowledge of soccer rules, and sportsmanship. Each student participating in this class will have individualized goals, which will focus on: improving skills, coordination, agility, speed, and strength.

_____ AV Club 2.0 - 3:30 – 4:30 (TBD)

Open to ages 11 – 19. Students will participate in all aspects of putting a weekly, five-minute news report together for the entire school. Writers will summarize national, local, and school stories, reporters will interview students and staff, and production staff will direct, film, and edit the material into a cohesive whole. Every student will have the opportunity to participate in each of these critical levels of the process, while also practicing real “news team” skills such as: collaborative problem solving, writing and technical support (i.e. iMovie, green screen set up, etc.). Both non-verbal (i.e. students using AAC devices) and verbal communicators will have the opportunity to anchor the news.
