_____ **Sensory Art – 3:30 – 4:30 (Art Room)**

Open to ages 6 - 10. This class will focus on discovery and exploration in the context of art making! The artists in this class will get a little messy, but all in the name of sensory experiences and art. _____AV Club 2.0 (For both beginners and experienced Journalists) – 3:30 – 4:30

Open to ages 11 - 18. Students will participate in all aspects of putting a weekly, five-minute news report together for the entire school. Writers will summarize national, local, and school stories, reporters will interview students and staff, and production staff will direct, film, and edit the material into a cohesive whole. Every student will have the opportunity to participate in each of these critical levels of the process, while also practicing real “news team” skills such as: collaborative problem solving, writing and technical support (i.e. iMovie, green screen set up, etc.). Both non-verbal (i.e. students using AAC devices) and verbal communicators will have the opportunity to anchor the news.

_____Sensory Art - 3:30 – 4:30 (Art Room)

Performers in this class will learn about speaking and performing for an audience, practice acting games, and be responsible for assigning roles, creating costumes and props, designing a set, and inviting their friends and family to their performance! Through discussing the emotions and motives of characters in the story, acting out roles, and planning their production, students will build their perspective-taking and collaborative problem-solving skills in a fun setting. Students will experience continued practice with gross motor and bilateral coordination, along with sharing and turn-taking opportunities.

_____ **AAC in The Community – 3:30 – 4:30 (Art Room)**

Open to ages 6 - 18. AAC in the Community is a great way to get more confident using a device at stores, restaurants, and anywhere your child needs to interact with people in their community. We will be visiting the grocery store, ordering food at restaurants (French fries, fro-yo, Starbucks, etc.) and asking store employees to help us locate items. Parents need to attend as much as possible as a way to become familiar with vocabulary and device usage. Students will use their devices (customized to student's current ability level) to practice the following skills: place an order using words, phrases or sentences, ask a community worker for help/directions, and greet/thank/end short conversations with the device. Parents will: become more familiar with device vocabulary, learn how to use devices "on the fly", and learn how to use Core Vocabulary in a variety of situations and environments.
